



What is the Community Advisory Committee?

The Community Advisory Committee (CAC) is composed of parents of students within the county, special education staff, other school personnel, representatives of other public and/or private agencies, and persons concerned with services for individuals with exceptional needs. A majority of the parents on the CAC must have children in special education.

The CAC provides school districts and the SELPA with community input regarding the development and implementation of the Local Plan for Special Education. It also serves as a forum for addressing the needs of ALL students with disabilities. The CAC encourages meaningful communication among school administrators, the Board of Education, parents, and communities.

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
